

II Timothy 2:1-26

The Appeal of Renewed

1 You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. *[Due September 20, 2023]*

2 And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others. *[Due September 27, 2023]*

3 Endure hardship with us like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. *[Due October 4, 2023]*

4 No one serving as a soldier gets involved in civilian affairs—he wants to please his commanding officer. *[Due October 11, 2023]*

5 Similarly, if anyone competes as an athlete, he does not receive the victor's crown unless he competes according to the rules. *[Due October 18, 2023]*

6 The hardworking farmer should be the first to receive a share of the crops. *[Due October 25, 2023]*

7 Reflect on what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all this. *[Due November 1, 2023]*

8 Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel, *[Due November 8, 2023]*

9 for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained. *[Due November 15, 2023]*

10 Therefore I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, with eternal glory. *[Due November 29, 2023]*

11 Here is a trustworthy saying: If we died with him, we will also live with him; *[Due December 6, 2023]*

12 if we endure, we will also reign with him. If we disown him, he will also disown us; *[Due December 13, 2023]*

13 if we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself. *[Due December 20, 2023]*

II Timothy 2:1-26

14 Keep reminding them of these things. Warn them before God against quarreling about words; it is of no value, and only ruins those who listen. *[Due January 17, 2024]*

15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth. *[Due January 24, 2024]*

16 Avoid godless chatter, because those who indulge in it will become more and more ungodly. *[Due January 31, 2024]*

17 Their teaching will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, *[Due February 7, 2024]*

18 who have wandered away from the truth. They say that the resurrection has already taken place, and they destroy the faith of some. *[Due February 14, 2024]*

19 Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness." *[Due February 21, 2024]*

20 In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. *[Due Feb. 28, 2024]*

21 If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work. *[Mar. 6, 24]*

22 Flee the evil desires of youth, and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart. *[Due March 13, 2024]*

23 Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. *[Due March 20, 2024]*

24 And the Lord's servant must not quarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. *[Due April 3, 2024]*

25 Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, *[Due April 10, 2024]*

26 and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will. *[Due April 17, 2024]*
